

## Other Community News

Over the years an increasing amount of dust has been coming off the un-named 8<sup>th</sup> St. to Hillcrest Cemetery road. This former highway, now a city road, was not allotted any funds to maintain a dust free surface and with no restrictions on traffic weight some sections had reverted to gravel. Although calcium chloride was applied at times an unacceptable amount of dust was blowing across many Briarwood homes.

The three condo complexes located on Bayfield Crescent lobbied City Hall throughout 2009 to have the road returned to a dust free surface. They were successful as at the city budget meeting on December 08, 2009, it was approved to chip seal the road in 2010. August is the current target date.

In the long term the city intends to close this road and return it to grass once the Taylor St. extension is completed and Rosewood fills out. Thanks to Councilors Tiffany Paulsen and subsequently Glen Penner for their assistance.
